SCHEDULING

Scheduling for students in grade nine, ten and eleven began in February. Counselors met with students on February 22nd. Registration material was distributed. Students were to speak with parents, counselors, and teachers regarding classes. Course registration forms are due March 9th. Students were to return a copy of their printed course request/alternate class sheet to their block two class. A parent signature is required on the registration form. Students and parents are encouraged to speak with their guidance counselor during March if any questions remain. Course request changes can be made through May 13th.

SAT/ACT Registration

Juniors need to think about taking an SAT or ACT this school year. There are still two SAT and one ACT test available this year. Test information and registration is available through Naviance.

OGT TESTING

OGT testing will take place Monday, March 12th through Friday, March 16th from 7:25 to 9:25am at LHS. Students should arrive and be seated in their assigned classroom by 7:20am. The test will be administered to all students in grade 10 and those students in grades 11 and 12 who have not yet passed sections of the OGT. All students in grade 9 will be taking an OGT practice test at the same time each day.

One test will be administered each day. The order of test administration is: Reading, Math, Writing, Science, and Social Studies. If school should be cancelled or delayed for any reason, students will take the test assigned for the day they return. If school is delayed, classes for ALL students will begin at the regular delayed starting time of 8:55am. Make-up testing will begin Monday, March 19th.

All students not involved in testing will attend classes Monday through Friday from 9:40am to 2:25pm and should plan to arrive at school by 9:30am in order to be in the classroom on time. Any non-testing students who arrive prior to 9:30am will report to the cafeteria and remain there until classes begin. Bus service will run at the regular times in the morning and afternoon all week for high school students.

Parents of non-testing students may wish to make alternative arrangements for transportation during this week. These students will not be counted absent from 7:25 to 9:40am.

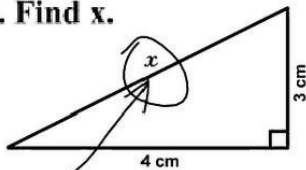
